



<b>HISTORY</b>	<p>CFS began serving members of Christian Fellowship Church in 1981. The initial enrollment of 24 students has grown to approximately 270 students in Preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Because of the overall success of the school program and the need in the Mid-Missouri area for Christian education, CFS opened its doors to the Mid-Missouri Christian community in August of 1992. Today, CFS students come from a variety of non-denominational and denominational backgrounds, including Baptist, Lutheran, Disciples of Christ, Evangelical Free and Assembly of God.</p>
<b>MISSION STATEMENT</b>	<p>The mission of Christian Fellowship School is • <i>to partner</i> with Christian parents • <i>to provide</i> quality Christian education • <i>to prepare</i> students for a lifetime of fruitful Christian service.</p>
<b>CURRICULUM</b>	<p>CFS utilizes the Splash into PreK curriculum in Preschool and A Beka, Purposeful Design, and BJU Press curriculum in elementary grades K - 6. Art, music, PE, chapel, band, library and computer skills classes supplement the elementary curriculum.</p> <p>CFS High School uses Christian textbooks from Bob Jones and A Beka, with some secular texts to support its educational objectives. Course work includes American and British Literature, Grammar, Vocabulary, Reading, Poetry, Composition I and II, Speech, Drama, Algebra I and II, Geometry, College Algebra, Analytical Trigonometry, Statistics, Calculus, Life Science, Earth Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, World History, U.S. History, American Government, Psychology, Spanish I, II, and III, Art I, II, III, IV, Band, Choir, Microsoft Applications I and II, Personal Finance, Health, Physical Education, Character Quest, Survival Quest, Synoptic Gospels, Christian Ethics, and World Views. AP courses are offered in Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Dual credit classes are offered in College Algebra, Analytical Trigonometry, Statistics, Calculus and English Comp. Additional course work is available through independent study. Juniors and seniors have access to numerous elective career and technical courses through a sending school agreement with the Columbia Area Career Center.</p>
<b>ACTIVITIES</b>	<p>Boys soccer (Fall), girls volleyball (Fall), boys and girls basketball (Winter), girls soccer (Spring), coed track (Spring) and boys baseball (Spring) teams compete with other Christian high school teams in the State of Missouri. There are also varsity and junior varsity cheerleading squads. State competition in art, drama, music and academics is coordinated through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). High school students may also participate on the yearbook staff, drama club, National Honor Society and Student Council.</p>
<b>SCHOOL UNIFORM</b>	<p>Students in grades K-5 and 6-8 wear a school uniform, with the uniform options varied by age and gender. For a complete description of the CFS uniform options, please review a copy of the uniform code in the school office, or on the school website under the Parents: Additional Resources section.</p>
<b>DRESS CODE</b>	<p>High school students in grades 9-12 follow a high school dress code.</p>
<b>ACT SCORES</b>	<p>The average ACT composite score for CFS graduating seniors over the past 5 years is 25.2. The National and State averages are 21.1 and 21.6, respectively.</p>
<b>AFFILIATIONS</b>	<p>CFS is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Oral Roberts University Educational Fellowship (ORUEF). CFS is accredited by both the International Christian Accrediting Association (ICAA) and North Central Association (NCA)/AdvancED.</p>

**Tuition Payment Options:** Tuition may be paid using any one of the following four options:

- X **Annual Payment Option** - a single payment of total tuition for the year due in the CFS office by August 1<sup>st</sup>. There is an additional **2% discount** for payment with the annual payment option.
- X **Semi-Annual Payment Option** -two payments (1/2 of the total yearly tuition) with the first payment due on August 1<sup>st</sup> and the second payment due on December 15<sup>th</sup>. There is an additional **1% discount** with the semi-annual option, which is discounted on the second payment (December 15<sup>th</sup>).
- X **Monthly Payment Option** - ten payments (August - May) will be automatically withdrawn from either a checking or a savings account by electronic withdrawal. The payment will be withdrawn on either the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month, with the date selected by the family.
- X **Semi-Monthly Payment Option** - twenty payments (August - May) paid twice per month and withdrawn automatically by electronic withdrawal on the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month (1/2 of the monthly amount each time).

**Application Fee:** Families wishing to apply for admission of students to CFS (Preschool - 12) must pay an Application Fee of \$20.00 per student, which is non-refundable. This fee is due at the time the application is submitted.

**Enrollment Fees:** An initial non-refundable enrollment fee of \$150.00 per child is due upon acceptance for admission to CFS for students who are enrolling for the first time in kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The enrollment fee for preschool is \$35.00. Preschoolers entering kindergarten are considered new enrollments.
